- Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

4. CLOSING DATES & ENTRY FEES.

4.1. ENTRY CLOSING DATES

Normal entry fee closing date is **Friday 8th January 2010**. For IRC competitors this must be paid to your series co-ordinator, Clubmans and Classics to Motorsport Manawatu direct.

Entries received after 8th January 2010 but before 21st January 2010 are subject to a late penalty of \$20.

Entries will close on Friday 21st January 2010 at 6pm.

4.2 ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY

We will update entry lists on our website, www.motorsportmanawatu.org.nz

Please check for your race number in your class list and then download the acceptance letter. If your number does not show, then please text or email so we can investigate for you.

4.3 ENTRY FEE REFUNDS POLICY

All competitors will receive a 100% refund if withdrawn in writing prior to Wednesday 13th January 2010. All competitors will receive a 50% refund if withdrawn in writing prior to Wednesday 20th January 2010. After this point no refund will occur.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS & UNDERSTANDING.

5.1 LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

The driver must hold as a minimum a National Race Grade Competition Licence, and be a financial member of a MNZ affiliated club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 NEW DRIVERS

Any new driver(s) who have not previously competed, and/or at this circuit must indicate the fact on the entry form and attend the New Drivers briefing session.

This will be advised in the acceptance of entry where it will be held.

5.3 COMPETITOR UNDERSTANDING

In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant & Driver) are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules.

In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and Code of Conduct.
- Schedule CH articles detailing conditions for MotorSport NZ Race Championships.

5.4 TIMING SYSTEM

Timing will be done by Tim Gibbes AMB transponder timing. If you do not have your own transponder you will need to hire one. This will need to be paid with your entry fee.

6 DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

6.1 DOCUMENTATION

Documentation will take place at the Secretary's office, bottom floor of the control tower.

Saturday 23rd January 2010 and will commence at **8am** until **12.30pm**.

Competitors **must** complete documentation prior to your official qualifying.

6.2 SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

Will take place in the scrutineering shed at the end of the dummy grid. You will be advised at documentation if your vehicle has been selected for audit. We may run audits in the square on Friday 22 January 2010.

7. POSTPONEMENT, CANCELLATION, ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS RIGHTS:

Pursuant to National Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 40 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

Should there be less than **12** entries received for any of the classes proposed in Article 3 of these Supplementary Regulations by the entry closing date, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that class or amalgamate it with another class at their sole discretion.

7.1 RAIN/WET MEETING POLICY (force majeure)

The programme is scheduled to run in fine weather. If in the case of rain, all races of duration of over 6 laps will be reduced to 6 laps first, and then after that, scheduled 6 lap races will be reduced to 5 laps to ensure that we comply with the maximum times associated with the noise management plan of Manfeild Park Trust.

8 COMPETITION NUMBERS

Preference will be given to competitors who have registered their permanent race numbers. These will be allocated by your series co-ordinator.

9. GENERAL INFORMATION

9.05 Friday 22nd January 2010 has been allocated as a test day for the meeting. This will cost \$50 inc GST for the day. There are no further discounts from this price. A schedule will be on the IRC website.

9.1 SATURDAY 23RD JANUARY TEST Session.

A test session has been allocated to each class prior to official qualifying. Any delays will result in shorter test times.

9.2 TICKETS

IRC Competitors have their allocated season passes. If you cannot present this at the gate you will have to pay the full entry price.

NZRF Classics and Clubmans will be sent their tickets prior to the meeting.

9.3 GARAGES

There are 1 types of pitbay available. **Full payment is required with booking.**

9.6 CAMPING

Camping is permitted, but please note the new power box policy above.

9.7 SET UP TIMES / TRACK OPENING

The facility has been hired for 22, 23 & 24 January 2010 only.

If you wish to set up earlier, please contact the Manfeild Park Office on 06 323 7444 to arrange.

A surcharge may apply.

9.8 SECURITY

We will arrange security for overnight Saturday and Sunday patrols. Outside of these times are at your own risk.

9.9 ACCOMODATION

The Kingsgate Hotel in Palmerston North has arranged a good rate for competitors. This can be booked through our website front page, or ring directly 06 356 8059. Make sure you mention Motorsport Manawatu while doing so.

10 PROGRAMME

The programme is very tight. To ensure you all get your full race programme, please ensure that you get to your grids on the outlap quickly and also complete the warm down lap as quickly as possible.

If you win the race please stop on the start line. You will be interviewed and given a chequered flag to complete the short loop. Burnouts and smoke is encouraged at this time.

If your car stops during a race, please try and get it as close to a rescue point safely for a speedy recovery. Please follow the instructions of the attending marshal at all times.

We have arranged a public display in the PN Square on Friday night between 4.30 and 7pm. We need 30 cars minimum to display. Please make sure you have class flags, stickers posters to give away. We will also be sharing the square with Motorbikes and Speedway machines so make you we put on the best show. You will be give vouchers to encourage people to attend. Take a pen so you can sign things!

On Saturday night at the completion of the last race, local band Yeah-nah will be playing from 7.15pm outside thee scrutineering shed. We will have a free BBQ and you can bring your own drinks. We encourage you to attend this has been arranged with you the competitor in mind. Have your prize giving here as well to make it a special evening.

Local cyclists will take to the track from 7.15pm until 9pm so please ensure you keep the dummy grid clear during this time, and co-operate with them so they return next time!
